



Counselor in Training Program

The CIT position is an exciting and fun opportunity to experience camp in a whole new way. This is a great opportunity to learn new skills, gain childcare experience, volunteer within the community and have fun at the same time!

CITs will apply either in person at Healdsburg High School or online at bishopsranch.org.

- CITs need to be 15 years of age by June 1st to apply.
- All CITs will need to complete an interview with the Camp Director. The Camp Director will call the CITs to set up the interview after receiving their application.
- CITs will be assigned to a session(s) of service, based on their availability. During their session(s), the CIT will work with a cabin and a staff member on a program schedule. Our Assistant Camp Directors will check in with CITs during each session to discuss their experience and evaluate their time at the Ranch.
- Each CIT session can be used for 70 hours of community service or student service learning requirements. We will verify service with a letter at the end of the summer and any additional forms that may be required as requested.
- CITs who have their licenses are permitted to drive themselves to and from camp, but should not use their vehicles during the session without the written permission of their parents or guardians.
- CIT training will take place for one weekend overnight at the Bishop's Ranch. Dates will follow in an email after the application has been processed.

For READ Camp CITs

- Arrival: CITs should arrive by 7:30 am **Jul 10, 2023**
- Departure: CITs will be finished with their service at approximately 5:30 pm **Jul 16, 2023** and should be picked up promptly.

For BREAD Camp CITs

- Arrival: CITs should arrive by 1:00 pm the Sunday their session starts.
- Departure: CITs will be finished with their duties by 12:00pm on Friday and should be picked up promptly.
