t the Bishop's Ranch we have a tradition of hospitality that combines service, beauty, creativity, & spirituality to create a unique atmosphere where our visitors can wash the dust of everyday life from their souls amongst the beauty of God's creation.

The cost to provide this hospitality and care for the Ranch's property and land exceeds \$7,500 per day — more than \$50,000 a week. Guest fees cover less than 80% of those costs. The balance of the Ranch's annual costs are funded by donors who support the Annual Fund.


